Suncor's Montreal refinery obtained its ISO 14001 environmental certification in 2004. Since then, it has maintained its conformity to the requirements of this standard.

Field of application

The Montreal refinery is part of Suncor, one of Canada's leading integrated energy companies. Suncor's mission is to create energy for a better world. The organization's vision is to be the trusted steward of precious natural resources. Guided by our values, we lead the way toward economic prosperity, improved social well-being and a healthy environment for today and tomorrow.

The ISO 14001 Environmental Management System (EMS) of Suncor's Montreal refinery takes into account those elements that may have an impact on the environment and on our regulatory compliance. These elements are:

- Air Emissions Control
- Water Management
- Soil and Groundwater Testing
- Management of Residual Materials
- Emergency Response Planning



The issues facing the Montreal refinery include: market access, maintenance of regulatory compliance, emergency response management, and remaining on budget.

To be aligned with Suncor's values, the Montreal refinery's environmental policy will focus on continuous improvement, environmental protection, pollution prevention, compliance with regulations, and good stakeholder relations.

The EMS is applicable to Suncor's Montreal refinery's activities involving the manufacturing, storage, pumping and shipping of petroleum and petrochemical products, as well as those activities concerning the management of contaminated soil and hazardous substances that are the purview and responsibility of the appointed and acting vice-president.
