

Subject: Annual Warning Siren tests

Date: September 24th 2020

The Suncor Montreal Sulphur Plant in collaboration with the City of Montreal public safety, will conduct the annual test of its warning siren. The test will take place Thursday, September 24th 2020, at 16h45 and 16h52.

Every alert siren cycle will last at least three minutes.

The siren will emit a modulated sound that should be heard on the outskirts of the sulfur plant site.

This drill aims to make sure that all sirens are working correctly and assess the state of preparedness of all emergency first responders.
